



Master Action Learning Coach Certification Requirements (MALC)

Eligibility

Senior Action Learning Coach who has five hundred (500) documented hours of coaching and/or training and/or consulting in action learning. The hours must reflect diverse clients and projects.

Other Requirements

Noted presenter at conference(s) and published articles, chapters or books related to the WIAL method of Action Learning.

Process for certifying coaches as MALC

1. The candidate must be sponsored by a MALC
2. The candidate submits the documentation of hours, presentations or publications, other relevant documents and two (2) letters of recommendation extolling their qualities as an Action Learning Master to the Certification Committee Chair
3. The Certification Committee Chair forwards the references to the Certification Committee members.
4. Certification Committee members send their response to the Certification Committee Chair.
5. The Certification Committee Chair, based upon critique by the committee, communicates whether the candidate has met the requirements for certification to level of master coach.

Annual Requirements

Certification is considered current for a period of two (2) years. To renew your certification status you must:

In addition to the requirements for maintaining SALC, a MALC will at a minimum have 1 article published or present at a conference
